Saskatchewan Labour Force Statistics

October 2018

UNADJUSTED DATA

According to the Statistics Canada Labour Force Survey during the week covering October 7th to 13th, 2018, there were 575,200 persons employed in Saskatchewan. This is a decrease of 100 from September 2018 but 9,400 more than the number employed in October 2017.

Agricultural employment was 38,800 persons in October 2018, down 1,600 from the September 2018 level but 3,000 more than the October 2017 agricultural employment level of 35,800. Non-agricultural employment was 536,400 persons in October 2018. This is an increase of 1,500 from the September 2018 non-agriculture employment level of 534,900 and 6,400 more than October 2017.

The Saskatchewan <u>unemployment rate</u> for October 2018 was 5.4 percent. This is a decrease of 0.1 percentage points from the September 2018 rate of 5.5 percent but 0.3 percentage points higher than the October 2017 level of 5.1 percent.

Saskatchewan's <u>labour force</u> decreased by 600 to 608,000 persons in October 2018 from 608,600 persons in September 2018. This is 11,800 more than the October 2017 labour force of 596,200 persons.

The Saskatchewan <u>participation rate</u> fell 0.1 percentage points to 68.6 percent in October 2018 from 68.7 percent in September 2018. The October 2017 participation rate for Saskatchewan was 67.8 percent.

There were 32,800 persons <u>unemployed</u> in Saskatchewan during October 2018. This is a decrease of 500 from September 2018 but is 2,500 more than the number unemployed in October 2017.

SEASONALLY ADJUSTED DATA

On a <u>seasonally adjusted</u> basis there were 573,500 persons <u>employed</u> in Saskatchewan in October 2018, up 2,500 from the September 2018 level of 571,000 and is up 9,600 from the October 2017 employment level of 563,900 persons.

The Saskatchewan seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for October 2018 was 6.2 percent. This is a decrease of 0.2 percentage points from the September 2018 rate of 6.4 percent but 0.3 percentage points higher than the October 2017 rate of 5.9 percent.

CANADIAN DATA

Canadian <u>employment</u> increased by 17,300 persons in October 2018 to 18,771,200 persons from 18,753,900 persons in September 2018. In October 2017, there were 18,562,000 persons employed in Canada.

Canada's <u>unemployment rate</u> decreased 0.1 percentage points in October 2018 to 5.3 percent from the September 2018 level of 5.4 percent. In October 2017, Canada's unemployment rate was 5.7 percent.

The <u>seasonally adjusted</u> unemployment rate for Canada was 5.8 percent in October 2018. This is 0.1 percentage points lower than September 2018 and 0.4 percentage points lower than the October 2017 level of 6.2 percent.
