Low numbers of *Culex tarsalis* mosquitoes are being detected in southern and central Saskatchewan



WNV transmission risk is minimal to low. Risk level has risen from minimal to low in zone 3.



No infected WNV positive mosquitoes have been found in 2017.



Mosquitoes are most active on warm evenings and between dusk and dawn. Take precautions against getting bitten.
