New Well Completion Type for SAGD Wells

Effective June 11, 2018, the Ministry of Energy and Resources will be making changes to the licensing of Steam Assisted Gravity Drainage (SAGD) wells. SAGD wells will be required to be licensed as Permanent Oil/Steam Injection wells; this applies to both the well that is intended for injection, and the well that is intended for production.

All existing SAGD well completions in IRIS will be converted to Permanent Oil/Steam Injection. Applicable Business Associates (BAs) will be notified prior to any completion type changes to the legacy wells currently in operation.

All Permanent Oil/Steam Injection wells will be required to link the well completion to both a Battery (subtype 344) and Injection facility (subtype 506). It will no longer be necessary to submit a reclassification/recompletion application in order to inject steam in a SAGD producer, or to produce from a SAGD injector.

Cement bond logs, along with the required interpretations, will now be required on all Permanent Oil/Steam Injection wells.
