The Optometry Act, 1985
[subsection 11(2)]

SASKATCHEWAN ASSOCIATION OF OPTOMETRISTS – REGULATORY BYLAW AMENDMENTS

Pursuant to subsection 11(2) of *The Optometry Act, 1985*, The Optometric Professional Bylaws are amended as follows:

REGISTRATION

Bylaw 2.1 is amended to read:

“**2.1** In addition to any other requirements prescribed in *The Optometry Act, 1985* or this bylaw, an applicant for licensure shall provide to the Registrar a formal application for a license on the prescribed forms”.

Bylaw 3.1 is amended to read:

“**3.1** An application to the Registrar made pursuant to section 21 of *The Optometry Act, 1985* for a license or a license renewal shall be on the prescribed forms, shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed by Council, and shall be accompanied by proof that the applicant is insured under a contract of malpractice insurance per occurrence, at a minimum insured value determined by Council. The Registrar may refuse to issue a license, or renew a license, unless all licensing requirements have been met”.

Bylaw 3.2 is repealed.

Bylaw 3.3 is renumbered as 3.2 and is amended to read:

“**3.2** To be eligible for and granted a license, an applicant must have the knowledge, skills and abilities that are substantially equivalent to the standards of academic or technical achievement, and competencies as outlined in these bylaws, and:

- (a) has demonstrated the applicant’s skill and knowledge through an assessment in such form as may be established by the Council; or
- (b) has demonstrated the applicant’s skill and knowledge in an examination established or adopted by the Board of Examiners and the Registrar; or
- (c) an applicant who graduated from an accredited school of optometry prior to January 1, 2015, that meets all licensing requirements, and when applying for an initial license, shall provide evidence of successfully completing a Therapeutic Pharmaceutical Agents Certification and an Advanced Scope of Practice Certification Course or an equivalent course as determined by the Registrar. Advanced Scope of Practice Certification requires clinical and technical proficiency in the diagnosis, treatment and management of patients with glaucoma, and the prescribing of oral medications for eye disease”.

Bylaw 3.4 is repealed.

Bylaw 3.5 is renumbered as 3.3 and is amended to read:

“3.3 The Registrar may ask for clarification of any information provided by an applicant applying for a license or a renewal of a license and may withhold the granting of a license until that information has been provided”.

Bylaw 3.6 is renumbered as 3.4 and is amended to read:

“3.4 The Registrar may issue a temporary license to an applicant on an exception basis and when it is the Registrar’s opinion all conditions of licensure will be met within the time frame specified”.

Bylaw 4.1 is amended to read:

“4.1 There shall be a Board of Examiners consisting of a minimum of five members who are residents in Saskatchewan and are appointed by Council of the association”.

Bylaw (4.8)(a)(i) to (v) is amended to read:

“(a) For the purpose of section 16 of *The Optometry Act, 1985*, schools or colleges of optometry recognized by Council are:

- (i) the School of Optometry of the University of Waterloo; or
- (ii) the School of Optometry of the University of Montreal; or
- (iii) a school or college of optometry of any other university which is recognized by the University of Saskatchewan and which grants the degree of Doctor of Optometry; or
- (iv) a school or college of optometry recognized and accredited by the Accreditation Council of Optometric Education and which grants the degree of Doctor of Optometry; or
- (v) a school or college of optometry that is recognized by the University of Waterloo, and in which case an individual graduate from such a school is approved to challenge the Canadian entry to practice examination as determined by Council”.

Bylaw 4.14 is repealed.

Bylaw 4.15 is repealed.

Bylaw 6.1 is amended to read:

“6.1 In the practice of optometry a member should exercise reasonable decision making based on Guidelines and shall follow the generally accepted Standards of Practice in the determination of the state of the eye and its adnexa, and in the assessment and care of the patient”.

Bylaw 6.2 is amended to read:

“6.2 Standards of Practice shall be updated from time to time at the direction of Council to better define procedures considered necessary for compliance with Standards of Practice required in section 6.1”.

Bylaw (8.1)(q) is amended to read:

“(q) treats or attempts to treat an eye or vision problem which the member recognizes or should have recognized as being beyond their experience or competence”.

The following Bylaw is added after Bylaw 8.1

“8.2 Optometrists must maintain professional boundaries with their patients and not exploit the patient in any way. The following issues are pertinent to situations where the patient-optometrist relationship may be compromised by sexualized behavior.

- (a) trust is the basis of the patient-optometrist relationship;
- (b) the onus is always on the optometrist to maintain professional boundaries with a patient and not to exploit the patient in any way. The nature of a fiduciary relationship makes a consensual sexual relationship between an optometrist and patient impossible;

- (c) the patient is considered to be the vulnerable individual in the professional relationship in which assistance and treatment are sought from a professional individual with knowledge and training to make diagnoses and treatment decisions;
- (d) power imbalance exists in the patient-optometrist relationship, and transference may develop as a result of the power imbalance;
- (e) sexualized behavior in the patient-optometrist relationship is never acceptable. A breach of sexual boundaries has potential for significant harm to the patient as the optometrist cannot provide objective care when a sexualized relationship exists;
- (f) patient-optometrist relationships shall be conducted as outlined in the Standards of Practice”.

Bylaw 9.10(a) is amended to read:

“9.10 Subject to section 9.12, it is a conflict of interest for a member to engage in the practice of optometry as an employee of, or in any form of association with or partnership with any person or corporation other than:

- (a) with an active member or with a part-time member who is engaged in the practice of optometry. For the purposes of this subsection an active member is one who practices in Saskatchewan a minimum of 750 hours in the preceding three years, and a part-time member is a holder of a part-time license as defined in SAO Policy”.

Bylaw 9.10(c) is amended to read:

“(c) as an employee or agent of a municipal government, agency of a municipal government, a University or a health authority”.

Bylaws 11.1 to 11.5 are repealed.

Bylaw 11.6 is amended to read and is renumbered as 11.1:

“11.1 A member providing antiglaucoma treatment must have a working relationship with an ophthalmologist who is accessible for consultation, collaboration and transfer of care when referral is required as per the bylaws and the Saskatchewan Association of Optometrists Treatment Standard of Practice”.

Bylaw 11.7 is repealed.

COMPULSORY CONTINUING EDUCATION

Bylaw 12.1 is repealed and replaced with the following:

“12.1 Members will be responsible to provide verification they have met the continuing education requirements as defined within the Continuing Education Standard of Practice as specified by the Board of Examiners, the Registrar, and as approved by Council”.

Bylaw 12.3(a) and (b) are repealed.

Bylaws 12.4 and 12.5 are repealed.

Bylaw 12.6(a) and (b) are repealed.

Bylaw (13.1) is repealed and replaced by the following:

“13.1 An application for registration by a Professional Corporation shall meet the requirements as defined by Council, and shall be accompanied by the fees as prescribed by Council:

- (a) during the first year of its registration, a professional corporation shall be required to pay both the registration fee and the fee for an annual permit; and
- (b) the fees above shall not be pro-rated for part of a year”.

Bylaw 13.5 is amended to read:

“13.5 To grant the renewal of an annual permit for a professional corporation shall be determined by the Registrar:

- (a) the fees for an annual professional corporation permit and renewal shall be determined by Council;
- (b) a late fee penalty for the renewal of a professional corporation permit if not paid by December 31 of the year immediately prior to the issuance of the annual permit shall be determined by Council”.

The Physical Therapists Act, 1998

[subsection 13(8)]

SASKATCHEWAN COLLEGE OF PHYSICAL THERAPISTS —
REGULATORY BYLAW AMENDMENTS

The Regulatory Bylaws of the Saskatchewan College of Physical Therapists are repealed and replaced by the following:

Title

1 These Bylaws may be referred to as *The SCPT Regulatory Bylaws Amendments, 2016*.

Definitions

2 In these Bylaws:

- (a) **“Act”** means *The Physical Therapists Act, 1998*;
- (b) **“client”** means a person for whom a physical therapist acts within a therapeutic relationship, the purpose of which is the treatment of a physical ailment;
- (c) **“recognized competency examination”** means the physical therapy competency examination administered by the Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators or an examination that is recognized by the council as equivalent of that examination;
- (d) **“recognized educational program”** means a physical therapy education program that is recognized by the council pursuant to clause 19(1)(c) of the Act;
- (e) **“specialized physical therapy procedure”** includes, acupuncture, dry needling, spinal manipulation and invasive techniques for the treatment of urogenital or rectal dysfunction.

MEMBERSHIP

Categories of membership

3 Membership in the college consists of the following categories:

- (a) practising membership;
- (a.1) extended access membership;
- (b) restricted practising membership;
- (c) academic practising membership;
- (d) non-practising membership;
- (e) temporary practising membership; and
- (f) honorary membership.

Practising membership

4(1) Practising membership is available to an individual who meets the requirements of subsection 19(1) or (1.1) of the Act and submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.

(2) Where an applicant for membership meets the requirements of subsection 19(1) of the Act and is registered as a physical therapist in another country, the applicant must demonstrate that he or she is a member in good standing and is fluent in English.

(3) Subject to obtaining a practising licence, practising membership entitles a member to:

- (a) use the title “Physiotherapist” or “Physical Therapist” or any other word, title or designation, whether or not abbreviated, to indicate that the individual is practising as a member of the college;
- (b) vote and hold office in the college;
- (c) speak and vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
- (d) serve as a representative of the college when appointed to do so;
- (e) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
- (f) receive the publications of the college.

Extended Access membership

4.1(1) Extended Access membership is available to an individual who meets the requirements of subsection 19(1.1) of the Act and submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.

(2) The applicant must demonstrate that he or she is fluent in English.

(3) Subject to obtaining an extended access licence, extended access membership entitles a member to:

- (a) use the title “Physiotherapist” or “Physical Therapist” or any other word, title or designation, whether or not abbreviated, to indicate that the individual is practising with an extended access membership as a member of the college;
- (b) speak but not vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
- (c) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
- (d) receive the publications of the college.

Restricted practising membership

5(1) Restricted practising membership in the college is available to an individual who:

- (a) meets the requirements of clauses 19(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Act;
- (b) has successfully completed the written component of a recognized competency examination; and
- (c) submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.

- (2) Subject to obtaining a practising licence, restricted practising membership entitles a member to:
- (a) use the title “Physiotherapist” or “Physical Therapist” or any other word, title or designation, whether or not abbreviated, to indicate that the individual is practising as a restricted practising member of the college;
 - (b) speak and vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
 - (c) serve as a representative of the college when appointed to do so;
 - (d) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
 - (e) receive the publications of the college.

Academic practising membership

- 6(1) Academic practising membership in the college is available to an individual who:
- (a) meets the requirements of clauses 19(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Act;
 - (b) has received an appointment to the academic staff of a university in Saskatchewan in a program described in clause 19(1)(c) of the Act; and
 - (c) submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.
- (2) Subject to obtaining a practising licence, academic practising membership entitles a member to:
- (a) use the title “Physiotherapist” or “Physical Therapist” or any other word, title or designation, whether or not abbreviated, to indicate that the individual is practising as an academic member of the college;
 - (b) speak and vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
 - (c) serve as a representative of the college when appointed to do so;
 - (d) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
 - (e) receive the publications of the college.

Non-practising membership

7(1) Non-practising membership in the college is available to an individual who is eligible for registration as a practising member but is not currently practising physical therapy in Saskatchewan, and who submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.

- (2) Non-practising membership entitles a member to:
- (a) speak and vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
 - (b) serve as a representative of the college when appointed to do so;
 - (c) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
 - (d) receive the publications of the college.

Temporary practising membership

- 8(1) Temporary practising membership in the college is available to an individual who:
- (a) wishes to be registered for a specific period of time in order to attend or instruct as a physical therapist at a continuing education course or event;
 - (b) meets the requirements of subsection 19(2) of the Act; and
 - (c) submits a completed application in the form provided by the college.
- (2) Subject to obtaining a practising licence, temporary practising membership entitles a member to use the title “Physiotherapist” or “Physical Therapist” or any other word, title or designation, whether or not abbreviated, to indicate that the individual is practising as a temporary practising member of the college.

Honorary membership

9(1) Honorary membership in the college is granted by resolution of the council in recognition of distinguished service to the profession to an individual who:

- (a) is a former practising member of the college who is retired from the practice of physical therapy; or
- (b) is not a physical therapist or is a physical therapist registered outside Saskatchewan.

(2) Honorary membership entitles a member to:

- (a) speak but not vote at the annual and special meetings of the college;
- (b) receive a copy of college documents appropriate for distribution; and
- (c) receive the publications of the college.

LICENSURE**Licence year**

10 The licence year of the college is the period commencing on April 1 in one year and ending on March 31 in the next following year.

Licence required

11 Every practising member shall obtain a licence in each licence year.

Insurance and criminal record check required

12 Every applicant for a practising licence of any kind shall:

- (a) maintain professional liability insurance in an amount not less than \$5,000,000 on any one client or \$5,000,000 maximum for the policy year, with no deductible; and
- (b) provide a satisfactory criminal record check.

Full practising licence

13(1) A practising member who submits a completed application in the form provided by the college is eligible to obtain a full practising licence, if the member:

- (a) has completed 1200 practice hours of physical therapy practice anywhere in the world within the five-year period immediately preceding the date of the licence application;
- (b) has successfully completed a recognized educational program within the four-year period immediately preceding the date of the licence application; or
- (c) has successfully completed a recognized competency examination within the four-year period immediately preceding the date of the licence application.

(2) A practising member who has not completed 1200 practice hours as described in clause (1)(a) is eligible to obtain a full practising licence but must satisfactorily complete a period of supervised practice:

- (a) under the direction of a member with a full practising licence who is approved by the council;
- (b) in a physical therapy facility or facilities approved by the council; and
- (c) for the total additional number of hours that would be required to be obtained to be eligible for full practising licensure in the current licence year and the next licence year; and
- (d) in accordance with a supervision agreement and a supervision plan approved by council, which plan is developed for the member by the member's supervisor and includes provisions for monitoring the member's practice, for personal intervention, and for any other matters that the member's supervisor or council considers necessary.

(3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to an application for an initial licence from an applicant who becomes a member in accordance with subsection 19(1.1) of the Act.

Extended Access Licence

13.1(1) An extended access member who submits a completed application in the form provided by the college is eligible to obtain an extended access licence.

(2) A member who holds an extended access licence may only provide physical therapy services, using information and communication technologies or in person, to patients located in Saskatchewan:

- (a) for the purpose of continuing to provide patient care to patients whose physiotherapy began in the primary jurisdiction and who would benefit from continued and time-limited service in the secondary jurisdiction; or
- (b) where services are not otherwise available in the secondary jurisdiction and the patient would benefit from such services.

(3) For the purposes of this section:

- (a) **“primary jurisdiction”** means the other Canadian jurisdiction in which the member is currently registered and in which the majority of their practice is physically situated;
- (b) **“secondary jurisdiction”** means Saskatchewan.

Restricted practising licence

14(1) A restricted practising member who submits a completed application in the form provided by the college is eligible to obtain a restricted practising licence.

(2) A restricted practising licence is valid for a maximum of 24 months, during which time the member must successfully complete the oral/practical component of a recognized competency examination and obtain a full practising licence.

(3) A member who holds a restricted practising licence may only practise:

- (a) under the direction of a member with a full practising licence who is approved by the council;
- (b) in a physical therapy facility or facilities approved by the council; and
- (c) in accordance with a supervision agreement and a supervision plan approved by council, which plan is developed for the member by the member’s supervisor and includes provisions for monitoring the member’s practice, for personal intervention, and for any other matters that the member’s supervisor or council considers necessary.

Academic practising licence

15(1) An academic practising member who submits a completed application in the form provided by the college is eligible to obtain an academic practising licence.

(2) An academic practising licence ceases to be valid if the member ceases to hold an academic appointment described in clause 6(1)(b).

(3) A member who holds an academic practising licence may practise only in the department of the university in which he or she holds an academic appointment and only to the extent required by the teaching, research and service requirements of that appointment.

Temporary practising licence

16(1) A temporary practising member is eligible to obtain a temporary practising licence for the period commencing on the first day of the event or continuing education course in Saskatchewan for which they have obtained temporary registration until midnight on the last day of the event or continuing education course.

(2) Physical therapists who are accompanying an athlete or team from another country, province or territory and who will provide physical therapy only to that athlete or team do not require a licence.

PHYSICAL THERAPY PROCEDURES

Basic procedures

17 Basic physical therapy procedures are those that may be performed through successful completion of educational programs necessary for membership in the college.

Specialized procedures

18(1) No member shall perform a specialized physical therapy procedure unless he or she has completed an educational program described in this section and recognized by the council.

(2) To be recognized by the council, a course in acupuncture must meet the following criteria:

1. Curriculum

- (a) minimum of 90 hours of instruction including both theoretical and practical components; and
- (b) course content must include, but is not limited to: theoretical basis of acupuncture, safety, infection control, indications, contraindications, precautions, point location and relevant anatomy, needling technique;

2. Examination

- (a) a formal written and practical examination must be utilized to determine level of competency;

3. Principal Instructor and External Examiner

- (a) must hold an AFCI, University of Alberta or equivalent certification in acupuncture;
- (b) must have a minimum of five years' experience following certification; and
- (c) must have previous experience participating in a course, for example as an instructor, lab demonstrator or teaching assistant.

(3) To be recognized by the council, a course in dry needling must meet the following criteria:

1. Curriculum

- (a) minimum of 90 hours of instruction including both theoretical and practical components; and
- (b) course content must include, but is not limited to: theoretical basis of dry needling, safety, infection control, indications, contraindications, precautions, point location and relevant anatomy, needling technique;

2. Examination

- (a) formal written and practical examination must be utilized to determine level of competency;

3. Principal Instructor

- (a) must hold an AFCI, University of Alberta or equivalent certification in dry needling;
- (b) must have a minimum of five years' experience following certification; and
- (c) must have previous experience participating in a course, for example as an instructor, lab demonstrator or teaching assistant.

(4) For the purposes of subsection (2) and (3), the number of hours of instruction in a course includes the hours required in any pre-requisite courses.

(5) Notwithstanding any other provision of these bylaws, a member who completed a course in dry needling that was recognized by the council at the time it was completed, may continue to perform those specialized physical therapy procedures within the limits of the member's education and training.

- (6) To be recognized by the council, a course in spinal manipulation must:
- (a) be included in a recognized educational program;
 - (b) be provided by a member organization and meet the standards of the International Federation of Orthopedic Manipulative Physical Therapists; or
 - (c) provide education to the same level as a course described in clause (a) or (b).
- (7) To be recognized by the council, a course in the treatment of urogenital and rectal dysfunction with invasive techniques must include a practical component, an evaluation of the participant's knowledge and skill, and certification indicating successful completion of the course.

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

General standards

19(1) No member shall:

- (a) abuse a client, whether physically, sexually, verbally, psychologically or in any other manner;
 - (b) knowingly endanger the safety of a client;
 - (c) engage in the practice of physical therapy while impaired by alcohol or drugs;
 - (d) influence a client to change the client's last will and testament;
 - (e) wrongfully abandon a client;
 - (f) misappropriate property belonging to a client, employer or fellow employee;
 - (g) disclose confidential information about a client except as required or permitted by law;
 - (h) falsify or fail to maintain a client record;
 - (i) fail to inform an employer of the physical therapist's inability to accept specific responsibility in areas where special training is required or where the physical therapist does not feel competent to function without supervision;
 - (j) fail to report the incompetence or misconduct of a member or colleague;
 - (k) fail to comply with established standards of practice;
 - (l) fail without reasonable cause to respond to inquiries from the college regarding alleged professional misconduct or professional incompetence;
 - (m) conspire to participate in any act of professional misconduct;
 - (n) counsel a person to participate in any act of professional misconduct;
 - (o) obtain registration by misrepresentation or fraud.
- (2) For the purposes of clause (1)(a), "sexual abuse" includes:
- (a) sexual intercourse or any other form of sexual activity between a client and a member;
 - (b) touching of a sexual nature between a client and the member including:
 - (i) touching or massaging breasts or pelvic area, or any sexualized body part for any purpose other than that required for therapeutic evaluation or treatment;
 - (ii) kissing of a sexual nature.
 - (c) behaviour or remarks of a sexual nature between a client and member including:
 - (i) verbal or written comments, inappropriate procedures, gestures or expressions that are seductive or sexually demeaning to the client;
 - (ii) deliberately watching a client dress or undress, except for the purpose of assessment where the client has provided specific consent;

- (iii) failure to explain to the client the relevance of a procedure involving the breast or pelvic area;
- (iv) failure to receive consent for a procedure involving the breast or pelvic area;
- (v) subjecting a client to an examination of the breast or pelvic area in the presence of students or others without obtaining specific consent;
- (vi) questioning the client regarding the client's sexual performance, history, or orientation unless relevant to the client's assessment or treatment;
- (vii) discussion of a client's sexual performance, history or orientation unless clinically relevant.

Code of ethics

20 The Saskatchewan College of Physical therapists adopts, and all registrants shall comply with the Code of Ethical Conduct as approved by the Registrars Committee of The Canadian Alliance of Physiotherapy Regulators in May 2016 and as amended from time to time.

Concurrent treatment

21 No member shall provide physical therapy treatment to a client where:

- (a) the client is receiving treatment from another health care provider who has a dissimilar or conflicting treatment philosophy, approach or client care objectives;
- (b) the other health care provider treating the client has not been notified; or
- (c) the physical therapy services provided constitute duplication.

Alternative therapies

22(1) Members who engage in the practice of physical therapy and who also provide other services to clients shall ensure that they do not hold themselves out as a physical therapist when providing those other services or refer to the provision of those other services as physical therapy treatment.

(2) A member shall ensure that clients and third-party payers, if involved, are fully informed of which service provided to them is a physical therapy service and which is not, and shall keep clear and separate records, including billings, of physical therapy services and alternative therapy services provided.

(3) For the purposes of this section, “**practice of physical therapy**” means the use by a physical therapist of their specific knowledge, skills and professional judgment to improve individuals' functional independence and physical performance, manage physical impairments, disabilities and handicaps, and promote health and fitness.

Multi-disciplinary practices

23 Where a member is providing physical therapy services in a multi disciplinary setting, the member shall ensure that:

- (a) the client is informed of the differences in the roles of the physical therapist and that of other health care providers and of the client's right to refuse any or all parts of an assessment or treatment regardless of who is providing it; and
- (b) specific entries are kept of physical therapy services provided.

Assignment of tasks to support workers

24(1) A member is responsible for assessing the knowledge, training, experience and ability of a support worker and shall only assign tasks to the support worker that the support worker has the knowledge, training, experience and ability to perform.

(2) A member shall not assign any of the following tasks to a support worker:

- (a) initial review, assessment or reassessment of clients;
- (b) interpretation of referral diagnosis or prognosis;
- (c) interpretation of assessment findings, treatment procedures and goals or treatment;
- (d) interpretation of subsequent assessment findings, treatment procedures and goals of treatment;

- (e) planning, initiation and modifying to advance a treatment program;
 - (f) any tasks or procedures that put the client at a high risk or require continuous clinical judgment during their use;
 - (g) discharge planning;
 - (h) the determination of case load management;
 - (i) delivery of client education unless using approved pre-set packages/handouts of educational material.
- (3) A member shall only assign the task of laser or ultrasound treatment to a support worker when:
- (a) the support worker has received formal instruction and hands-on training in the use of laser and ultrasound that meets the requirements of *The Radiation Health and Safety Regulations, 2005*;
 - (b) the member has ensured that the support worker demonstrates competency and safety in the application of the tasks assigned;
 - (c) and the member has determined the dosage and adequately evaluated the client's response to treatment.
- (4) A member shall adequately and appropriately supervise a support worker in the support worker's performance of assigned tasks.

Performance of tasks by certain unregulated workers

25 A member who owns a facility providing physical therapy services shall ensure that a client who is known or suspected to have an acute or chronic disease process or injury is screened by a physical therapist to determine that the client can safely proceed with a specific exercise program or other treatment prior to seeing an unregulated health care provider who is employed by the member in the facility.

Use of instruments or devices

26 No member shall use any instrument or device in the provision of physical therapy services unless:

- (a) the instrument or device is appropriately maintained and calibrated;
- (b) the member has successfully completed any necessary training to become familiar with the use of the instrument or device and its clinical application; and
- (c) the client is informed of the limitations of the results and the steps to be taken based on the results.

Advertising

27(1) No member shall offer to guarantee a cure either verbally or in writing or by advertising or otherwise.

(2) No member shall engage in any advertising, promotion, or other marketing activities that:

- (a) are inaccurate or capable of misleading the public either directly or indirectly;
- (b) misrepresents facts;
- (c) compares either directly, indirectly or by innuendo, the member's services or ability with that of any other practitioner or clinic, or promise or offer more effective service or better results than those available elsewhere;
- (d) deprecates another member or clinic as to service, ability or fees;
- (e) create an unjustified expectation about the results the member can achieve;
- (f) are made under any false or misleading guise, or takes advantage, either physically, emotionally, or financially of any client, or uses coercion, duress, or harassment;
- (g) are incompatible with the best interests of the public or members, or tends to harm the standing of the physical therapy profession generally;
- (h) contain any testimonial or disclose the names of clients; or promote a specific brand of drug, device, or equipment.

GENERAL

Demanding college meetings

28 For the purposes of clause 6(2)(b) of the Act, the number of members required to demand a special meeting of the college is the number equal to 10% of the practising members.

Conflict of interest

29(1) A conflict of interest exists whenever a member has a vested interest in the outcome of a decision or proceeding involving the college, and includes any of the following situations:

- (a) where the member is involved in negotiating wages and/or employment contracts, or completing performance appraisals for college staff who may be related to that member;
- (b) where the member is involved in determining or reviewing credentials and registration or licensing eligibility for an applicant or another member who may be related to that member;
- (c) where the member is involved in the investigation or discipline hearing process affecting another member who may be related to that member;
- (d) where the member or family member might personally or financially benefit from decisions or information gained from involvement on council or a college committee.

(2) A member of the college serving in an official capacity as a council member, committee member or representative of the college shall declare a conflict of interest where one exists.

(3) Where a conflict of interest exists but is not declared as required by subsection (2), any other member of council or a committee who is aware of the conflict may declare it.

(4) Any dispute that arises about the existence of a conflict of interest is to be decided by a resolution of the council or committee, as the case may be.

(5) The presiding officer at a meeting at which a conflict of interest is declared shall ensure that a member identifying a conflict of interest leaves the meeting during consideration of the issue to which the conflict relates, and the secretary of the meeting shall record the fact and time of the departure of the member in the minutes.

(6) A member who represents the college shall not assume a position if a conflict of interest is identified.

(7) A member of the Professional Conduct Committee or the Discipline Committee who has a conflict of interest in relation to a particular complaint shall declare that interest and shall not take part in the investigation or hearing of the complaint.

Council review of delegated decisions

30 A person who applies for a review of a decision delegated to the Executive Director pursuant to subsection 20(4) of the Act shall forward his or her application to council in writing, stating the reasons for the application, within 30 days of having received the decision of the Executive Director.

Former regulatory bylaws repealed

31 All former regulatory bylaws of the college are repealed.

Coming into force

32(1) In accordance with subsection 13(8) of *The Physical Therapists Act, 1998*, these bylaws come into force when they are approved by the Minister and published in *The Saskatchewan Gazette*.

**EXTRACTS FROM THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE
LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF SASKATCHEWAN RELATING TO PRIVATE BILLS**

Only a Private Member, not a Member of Cabinet, can present a petition for a Private Bill. The Clerk of the Legislative Assembly must be advised in writing of the name of the Private Member sponsoring the Private Bill.

In cases where the proposed bill provides that the property to be used or occupied by the petitioner be exempt from taxation, either in whole or in part, the petitioner must file with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition, a written statement from the local municipal authority in which the said property is situated approving the intent of the provisions of the proposed bill which provide for the exemption from taxation.

91(1) All petitions for private bills shall be in duplicate and shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly not later than the fourth sitting day of the spring period of the parliamentary calendar.

91(2) No petition for any private bill shall be received by the Assembly if presented after the first eight sitting days of the spring period of the parliamentary calendar.

91(3) No private bill may be introduced in the Assembly after the first 15 sitting days of the spring period of the parliamentary calendar.

92(1) Every applicant for a private bill shall deposit with the Clerk of the Assembly, along with the petition for same, two copies of the bill with marginal notes inserted and an accepted cheque payable to the Minister of Finance for the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) if the said bill does not exceed 10 pages, and fifteen dollars (\$15) additional for each page over that number; 450 words shall be held to constitute a page.

92(2) In the case of a bill incorporating a company, a receipt from the Director of Business Corporations for any statutory fees required shall also be deposited with the Clerk of the Assembly.

93 No remittance of a deposit on account of a private bill or any portion thereof shall be ordered by the Assembly unless the same has been recommended by the committee charged with its consideration, or unless the bill has been withdrawn, rejected or not reported upon, in which cases the actual expenses incurred shall be deducted from the deposit received before making such remittance.

...

95(1) All petitions to the Legislature for private bills of any nature whatsoever shall require a notice clearly and distinctly specifying the nature and object of the application and, where the same refers to any proposed work, indicating generally the location of the work, and signed by and on behalf of the petitioners, with the address of the party signing the same. When the petition is for an act of incorporation, the name of the proposed company shall be stated in the notice.

95(2) Such notice shall be published, prior to the filing of the petition with the Clerk of the Assembly as required in Rule 91(1), in two consecutive issues of *The Saskatchewan Gazette* and four consecutive issues of a newspaper published in English and having circulation in the locality affected.

95(3) A copy of the notice with a statutory declaration of the several publications of advertisement shall be filed with the Clerk of the Assembly along with the petition and bill.

96(1) The Law Clerk and Parliamentary Counsel shall examine all private bills for the purpose of seeing that they are drawn in accordance with the Rules of the Legislative Assembly respecting private bills.

96(2) Every bill for an act of incorporation, where a form of model bill has been adopted, shall be drawn in accordance with such model bill, copies of which may be obtained from the Clerk of the Assembly. Any provisions contained in any such bill which are not in accord with the model bill shall be inserted between brackets and shall be so printed.

EXTRAITS DES RÈGLES ET PROCÉDURES DE L'ASSEMBLÉE LÉGISLATIVE DE LA SASKATCHEWAN AU SUJET DES PROJETS DE LOI D'INTÉRÊT PRIVÉ

Seul un simple député, et non un ministre, peut présenter une pétition pour un projet de loi d'intérêt privé. Le greffier de l'Assemblée législative doit être avisé par écrit du nom du député qui parraine le projet de loi d'intérêt privé.

Si le projet de loi proposé prévoit que la propriété qui sera utilisée ou occupée soit exempte de taxes, en tout ou en partie, le requérant doit présenter au greffier de l'Assemblée législative, avec sa pétition, une déclaration écrite de l'autorité municipale locale où est située la propriété en question qui cautionne les dispositions portant sur l'exemption de taxes du projet de loi proposé.

91(1) Deux exemplaires des pétitions introductives de projets de loi d'intérêt privé sont déposés au greffier de l'Assemblée au plus tard le quatrième jour de séance de la session de printemps du calendrier parlementaire.

91(2) Seules sont recevables par l'Assemblée les pétitions introductives de projet de loi d'intérêt privé qui sont présentées dans les huit premiers jours de séance de la session de printemps du calendrier parlementaire.

91(3) Les projets de loi d'intérêt privé ne peuvent être déposés à l'Assemblée que dans les 15 premiers jours de séance de la session de printemps du calendrier parlementaire.

92(1) Les personnes qui demandent un projet de loi d'intérêt privé déposent auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée, outre la pétition connexe, deux exemplaires du projet de loi qui portent les notes marginales ainsi qu'un chèque visé payable au ministre des Finances d'un montant de deux cent cinquante dollars (250 \$) si le projet de loi en question compte au plus 10 pages, montant auquel il faut ajouter quinze dollars (15 \$) par page supplémentaire; une page est réputée compter 450 mots.

92(2) Si un projet de loi prévoit la constitution d'une société, un récépissé des droits réglementaires donné par le registraire des sociétés par actions est également déposé auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée.

93 L'Assemblée n'ordonne aucune remise totale ou partielle d'un dépôt, sur le compte d'un projet de loi d'intérêt privé, sauf si le comité chargé de l'étudier émet une recommandation contraire, si le projet de loi a été retiré ou rejeté ou s'il a fait l'objet d'un rapport, auxquels cas les dépenses réelles sont déduites du dépôt reçu avant de procéder à la remise.

...

95(1) Toutes les pétitions introductives de projets de loi d'intérêt privé à l'adresse de la Législature nécessitent un avis qui expose clairement la nature et l'objet de la demande et qui est signé par les requérants et en leur nom, avec mention de l'adresse des signataires. Les avis qui visent des travaux proposés font état de leur emplacement; ceux qui visent une loi de constitution en société font état du nom de la société.

95(2) Avant le dépôt de la pétition auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée, les avis requis en vertu du paragraphe 91(1) sont publiés dans deux numéros consécutifs de la *Gazette de la Saskatchewan* et quatre numéros consécutifs d'un journal publié en anglais diffusé dans la localité touchée.

95(3) Outre la pétition et le projet de loi, sont déposées auprès du greffier de l'Assemblée, une copie de l'avis et une déclaration solennelle qui atteste les diverses publications de l'annonce.

96(1) Le légiste et conseiller parlementaire étudie tous les projets de loi d'intérêt privé afin de s'assurer qu'ils sont rédigés conformément aux articles du Règlement de l'Assemblée législative relatifs aux projets de loi d'intérêt privé.

96(2) Si une formule type de projet de loi a été adoptée, les projets de loi portant constitution des sociétés sont rédigés selon cette formule, dont les exemplaires peuvent être obtenus chez le greffier de l'Assemblée. Les dispositions de ces projets de loi qui ne se conforment pas à la formule type sont indiquées et imprimées entre crochets.
