## CHAPTER A-22 REG 1

### *The Apiaries Act*

#### Title

- 1** These regulations may be cited as *The Apiaries Regulations*.

#### Interpretation

- 2** In these regulations:

- (a) **“Act”** means *The Apiaries Act*;
- (b) **“Africanized bees”** means honey bees (*Apis mellifera adansonii*) of the African race and hybrids of European and African races;
- (c) **“honey bee tracheal mite”** means a parasitic mite (*Acarapis woodi*) of honey bees;
- (d) **“quarantine zone”** means a geographical area, defined by the minister, in which the movement of bees and beekeeping equipment is prohibited without written permission of the minister;
- (e) **“Varroa mite”** means a parasitic mite (*Varroa jacobsoni*) of honey bees.

#### Interpretation

- 3** For the purposes of section 10 of the Act, **“quarantine”** means the prohibition of movement of bees and beekeeping equipment from an apiary within a quarantine zone without the written permission of the minister.

#### Tracheal mite declared disease

- 4** The honey bee tracheal mite is hereby declared to be a disease for the purposes of the Act.

#### Varroa mite declared disease

- 5** The Varroa mite is hereby declared to be a disease for the purposes of the Act.

#### Africanized honey bee declared disease

- 6** The Africanized honey bee is hereby declared to be a disease for the purposes of the Act.

**Compensation**

**7** Where the minister or his agent orders the destruction of bees or beekeeping equipment pursuant to subsection 12(1) of the Act as a result of an infestation of honey bee tracheal mite, the minister may provide compensation to the owner of the bees or beekeeping equipment based on their fair market value as determined by the minister.
